

Regulation

AD HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Advisory committees may be established by the board to assist the board in special studies in regard to the school system. The board of education in consideration of recommendations, retains the ultimate responsibility for policy decisions. Committees shall be formed and operate in accordance with district regulations. These guidelines have been established by the board:

- A. The board shall define the charge and scope of the study and establish a time schedule and request such interim reports as may be required. The committee shall be allowed to work freely under these guidelines;
- B. The committee shall be broadly representative of the entire community;
- C. A board member shall be appointed by the board president as liaison to the committee. Such person or alternate shall attend all general committee meetings;
- D. The citizen advisory committee shall report directly and only to the board;
- E. The committee is ad hoc by nature; once its charge has been completed, the committee shall be dissolved by the board.
