SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

The board of education recognizes that the grouping of grades and services within the facilities of the district can assist the efficient operation of the district and help achieve a more effective instructional program

The schools of this district shall be organized by schools as follows:

Dickerson School	Kindergarten through Grade Two
Bragg School	Grade Three through Grade Five
Black River Middle School	Grade Six through Grade Eight

Modifications in the organizational plan of the schools may be made by the board upon the recommendation of the chief school administrator. The chief school administrator shall continually monitor the effectiveness of the school's organizational plan and recommend to the board such modifications in the plan which are in the best interests of the students, make wisest use of district resources and serve the educational goals of this board.
