FOR KIDS AND FAMILIES:

WINTER FULL MOON NIGHT HIKE February 20 (Saturday) 7:30 pm

A two-mile guided hike along Schiff's moonlit trails appropriate for ages 7 and up. Members pay \$5 per person or \$15 for the immediate family; non-members pay \$10 per person or \$30 per family.
