The purpose of this public meeting is to present plan elements and receive public input on the recommendations. The meeting will be in an open house format allowing visitors to review materials, ask questions, and voice their opinions with local team members and representatives from NJDOT. Your participation and input are vital to a successful project!

Over the past 12 months, a group of Chester citizens formed the Bicycle & Pedestrian Planning Committee, and worked together to develop a plan to improve cycling and walking conditions throughout the community. We are really excited about the plan we put together, and think you will be too. It creates a bicycle and pedestrian network that links parks, schools, and neighborhoods with the center of town. The plan will improve safety and mobility of non-motorized travel in our community, and serve as the basis for implementing future bicycle and pedestrian projects in Chester.
