3. **Wear proper concert attire.** We have asked the children to not wear T-shirts, jeans, flip-flops, and if possible, sneakers. For safety reasons, any open shoes should have a strap that goes around the back of the foot. Please stress to your children that this is a special occasion, and such occasions require them to look their best.
4. **Enjoy the concert experience.** To ensure the best atmosphere for all involved, we ask that all children not performing be accompanied by an adult at all times. Please accompany crying children out into the hallway, as to not disturb the performers. Please remain quiet during the performance out of courtesy for the performers and other audience members.
